The Classic Screwdriver Cocktail

Ingredients:

Ingredient	Amount	Notes
Orange juice	4 to 6 ounces	
Vodka	1½ ounces	1 shot
Ice cubes	1 cup	

My Easy Screwdriver Recipe

Step 1 Grab a tall glass for your drink. Fill it to the top with fresh ice cubes. Cold ice makes a better, crisper cocktail. Always start with a chilled glass if you can.

Step 2 Pour in one and a half ounces of vodka. Use a good quality vodka for a smoother taste. Cheap vodka can sometimes taste too strong. (My hard-learned tip: measure your vodka with a jigger for the perfect balance). **Step 3** Slowly add your orange juice. Fill the glass almost to the very top. Use your favorite brand of juice, fresh is best. Stir it gently just once or twice to mix. **Step 4** Now for the final touch, add a garnish. An orange wheel on the rim looks classic. A maraschino cherry adds a fun splash of color. Serve your drink immediately for the best flavor. **What is the main ingredient in a classic Screwdriver cocktail? Try These Fun Twists

This simple drink is so easy to change up. You can make it special for any season or mood. I love getting creative with different juices and

flavors. Here are three of my favorite spins to try at home. **The Sunset Splash** Use blood orange juice instead of regular. It is a bit less sweet and has a beautiful color. It feels fancy but is just as simple to make.

The Sparkling Screwdriver Replace half the orange juice with club soda. This gives your drink a light, fizzy feeling. It is perfect for a hot summer afternoon on the patio. **The Spicy Citrus** Muddle a slice of jalapeño in the glass first. Then add your ice and build the drink as normal. It gives you a nice little kick with each sweet sip.

Serving Your Perfect Drink

This cocktail is a star at any brunch or party. I always serve it with salty snacks like pretzels. It also pairs well with a simple bacon and egg dish. The sweet and salty combo is just right. For drinks, keep it simple. Iced coffee or tea works for a non-alcoholic option. A cold light beer is a great pairing if you want something else. It is all about keeping things easy and refreshing. **So, which would you choose tonight: a salty snack or a sweet one?**

Keep Your Screwdriver Fresh

Make it right before serving for best taste. I never make these ahead. The orange juice gets bitter. Keep vodka in the freezer for a super cold drink. It stays smooth and never freezes solid.

Use a good orange juice. Fresh squeezed is my favorite. It makes a huge difference in flavor. My grandson once used cheap juice. We both made a funny face! Quality matters for a simple drink.

Fix Common Problems

Is your drink too weak? Add a little more vodka. Start with one shot. You can always add more. Too strong? Just add more orange juice. It is your drink, after all.

If it tastes flat, your juice might be old. Always check the date on the carton. Use fresh ice cubes too. Stale ice can give a weird taste. What is your biggest cocktail problem?

Your Questions, Answered

Q: Is this drink gluten-free? A: Yes, most vodka is made from potatoes or corn. Always check your bottle's label to be safe. Some are made from wheat.

Q: Can I make a big batch for a party? A: Absolutely! Mix vodka and juice in a pitcher. Keep it chilled. Add ice to each glass you serve.

Q: What if I want to use fresh oranges? A: Squeeze them! About two oranges make one drink. It tastes so much brighter and better.

Q: Can I use a different juice? A: Sure, try cranberry or pineapple. It will change the flavor. It is a fun way to experiment.

Q: What is the best vodka for this? A: A mid-range, smooth vodka works perfectly. You do not need the most expensive bottle.


Cheers to Simple Pleasures
